Temple Chai Holds 1st Annual Kugel Cook-Off March 25

Attention all Kugel Mavens in San Antonio. Fire up your ovens for Temple Chai's 1st Annual Kugel Cook-Off to be held on Sunday, March 25 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. in the Holzman Auditorium of the Jewish Campus, 12500 N.W. Military Hwy.

The entire community is invited to submit kugel recipes – and then join in the fun of sampling all kugels, along with a light lunch of “build your own salad or sandwich” for \$5 per person. You don't have to enter a kugel to come for lunch: be a “professional eater” and help choose one of the winners.

Enter your favorite savory or sweet kugel recipe. All kinds of noodles may be used: wheat noodles, gluten-free or egg-free noodles, or even differently shaped noodles. Submit your entry form plus a \$25 entry fee to Temple Chai Kugel Cook-Off, 1931 N.W. Military Hwy, Suite 231, San Antonio, TX 78213, postmarked no later than March 5.

Only the first 50 applications submitted will be accepted in the competition. Then on the day of the Cook-Off, competitors will bring their pre-cooked kugels (in a 9x15 pan) for judging. Winners and their recipes will be featured in a spring issue of the Jewish Journal.

Judges will include local community leaders, chefs and food writers to be announced. Prizes will be awarded for the *Ganza-Megilla Kugel* (grand prize) *Ah Zaer Goot* (runner-up) , and the *Fresser's Choice Kugel* (to be voted upon by the audience).
